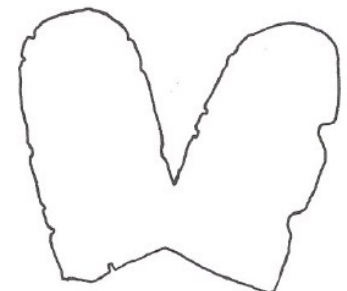
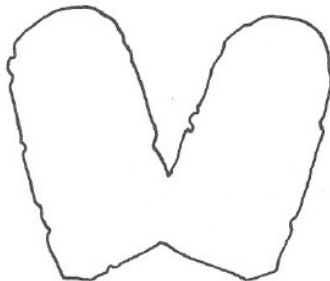
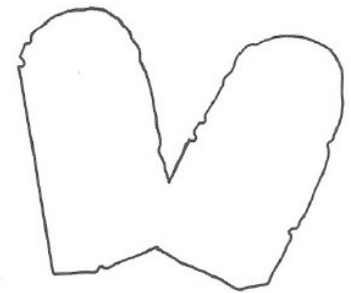
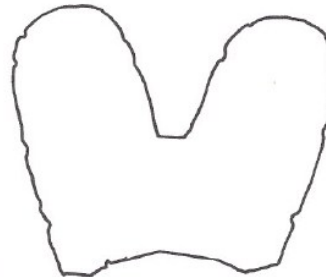
The Torah Scroll

God wrote out the Ten Commandment on Mount Sinai and gave them to Moses. Which outline fits the finished picture?



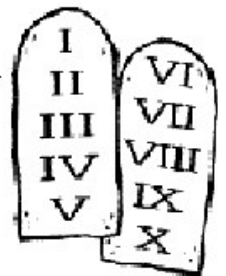
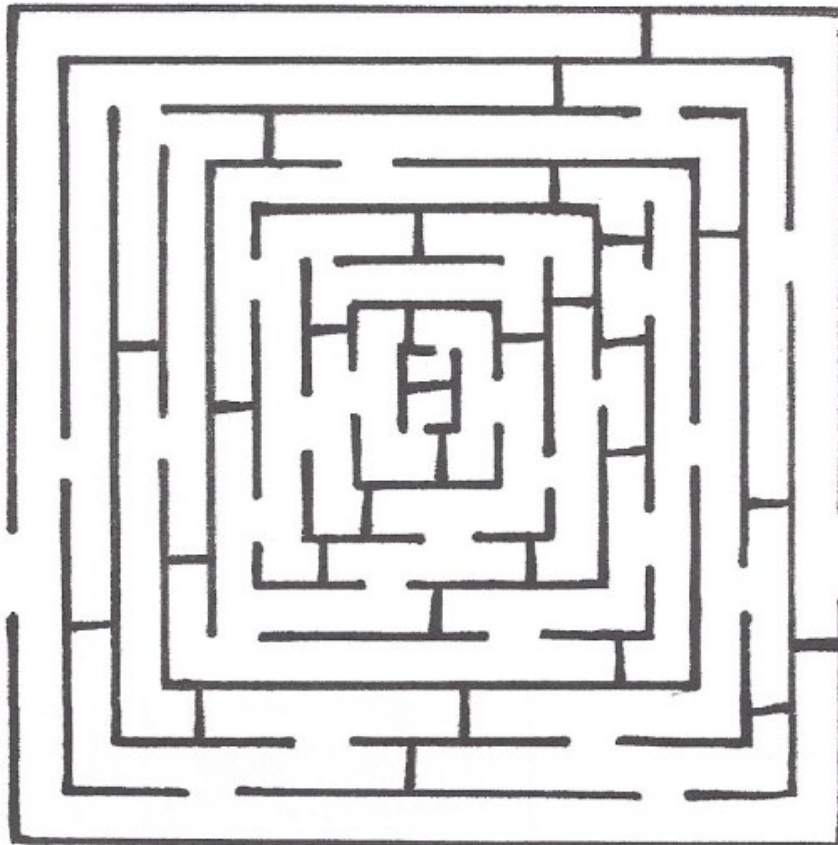
The People Prepare

The LORD required the people to wash to prepare to meet Him at Mount Sinai. How many funny mistakes has the artist put into this picture?



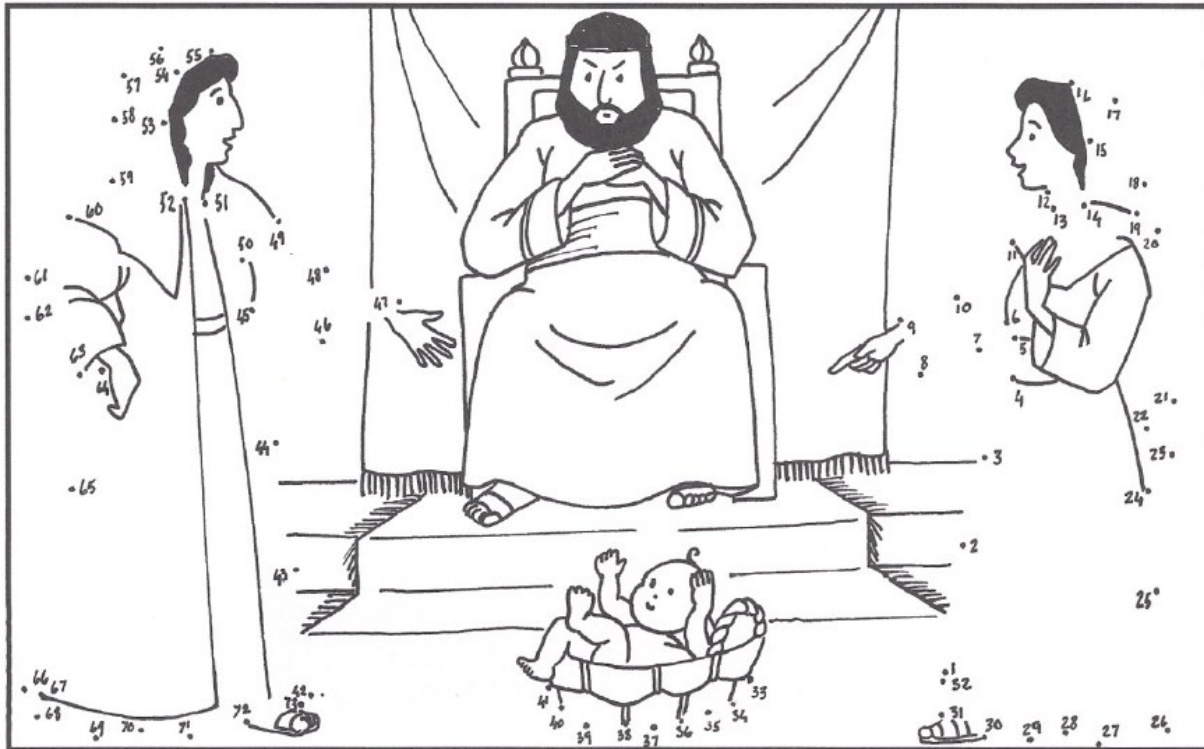
The Amazing Maze
